### **Elevate Buildings Initiative**

Peter Nelson, with the SLC Division of Sustainability and Ashley Miller, with Breathe Utah visited to present on the amount of air pollutants that come from buildings in our city. ### **RDA Draft Budget**

Jill Wilkerson-Smith with the RDA visited to discuss the North Temple Project Area. The RDA is accumulating funds to initiate a catalytic development along North Temple in the future. The City has been working on remediation of the contaminated land along that corridor.
