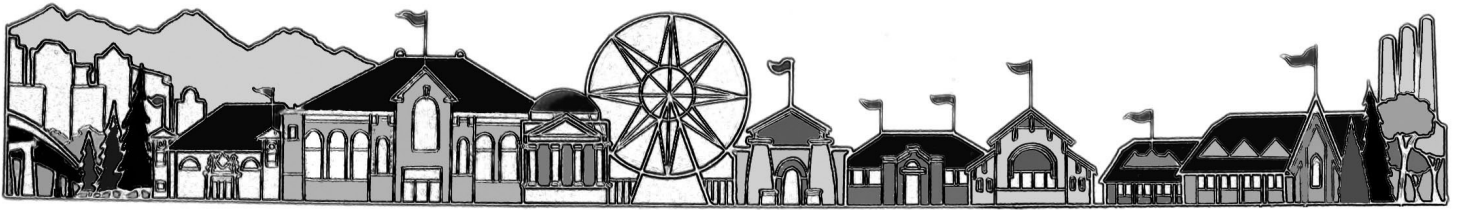

Fairpark Study in Final Stretch

On May 30th, the 3rd Progress Report of the CRSA's study on options for the future of the Utah State Fairpark was released. CRSA, the architectural firm contracted by the State to study options for the property, presented the report to the Legislature's Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee on June 18th.

The 94-page report summarized comments from individuals and organizations on the Fairpark's future, including comments submitted from the May 14th Open House and from CRSA's online survey.

Will New Library Put Fairpark Kids At Risk?

Funding for a study on the safety of Fairpark kids traveling along 300 and 400 North to the new Marmalade Library, was among the Mayor's budget recommendations passed by the City Council on June 10th. However the funding process has just begun for this study. In August, the City Council will begin prioritizing the projects that have requested funding, including the 300/400 North Intermodal Study. This ranking will determine what projects are actually funded. It is important that Fairpark residents and organizations let the City Council members know, while pleased with the new library, there is an ongoing concern for the safety of our children as they travel to and from the library.
