dept. - Would educate people on how to prep the area around their home within 5 feet
from their home and the Dept. would help find resources to help with that (e.g., chipper,

The Overnighter Motel – discussions with current owner as to what to do with the property.

Year round public market – analyzing the State Fairpark space – RDA looking at options –
looks positive

New overflow homeless facility open as of today (Sugarhouse) – The Shelter the Homeless
organization is overseeing it. Temporary through April (winter only). Open at night only.

Shuttles are available to get from downtown to there and back. Road Home Building will be

torn down. New housing complex opening up summer, targeted towards Homeless across from Sunrise Metro

4. **Mayor's Office Report** – Joshua Rebollo, Community Liaison, Dist 1 and 2
Census Coordinator – Census day is April 1 – openings for Census Taker
Responding to community input on Temporary Shelter
Food and Equity Advisors Program (Sustainability, Food and Equity Program) – 2 year pilot program to increase access to healthy food in marginalized communities – need 14-16 people to serve as advisory. Have to apply by Feb 21. Apply online – <http://bit.ly/2E7LYXu>

Transportation, Energy Programs (energy management, solar), **Advanced Manufacturing** (focus of tonight's presentation)

Medical Manufacturing Companies, Aerospace Companies (Training is funded through a legislative grant).
