vehicle theft up to 51

Be careful when you start your car in the morning to warm up

It is up all over the city --> up 51%

West Side Bike team is back--> report from last seven days ( 4 officers )

off north temple 11 felony arrests weapons and narcotics

seized drugs year to day 55 arrests, five firearms off the street

camera has moved across the street by the strip mall

AC is getting taken down, in the hands of the City--> end of April

Q| When is the bike squad out? Days off Sat,Sun, Mon work 2:30- past midnight Swing Shift
