- Vacancy for District 2 (Andrew Johnston's seat – moving into the senior policy director of homeless services); Council has also voted to implement rank choice voted for 2021 elections. Complicates the Dist. 2 race because of a state statute that says the replacement can happen but has to run for re-election in the next election.

- Airport Inn -council did an emergency winter shelter there (adjacent to our community council district). Will not go past June. The owner was approached by the city to purchase the hotel for housing (semi-affordable, semi-permanent – could be used for people who are transitioning from homelessness to government housing – for elderly and veterans)

- Inland Port – in litigation (Utah Supreme Court) City seemed to do well. Hopefully a decision will be put out soon.

- North Temple Friday meetings - Andrew Johnston will continue these meetings.
